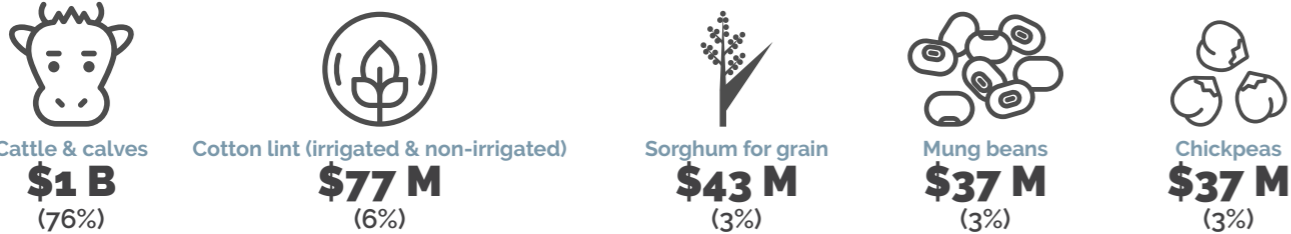

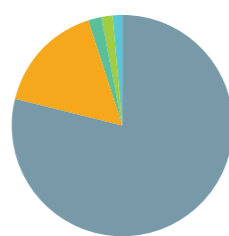
Top 5 industries by employment:



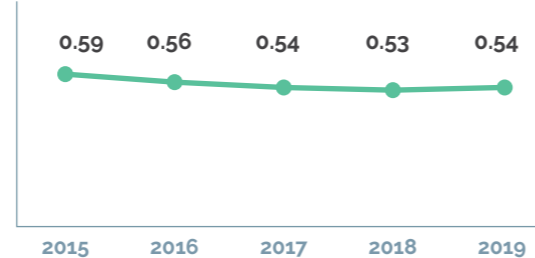

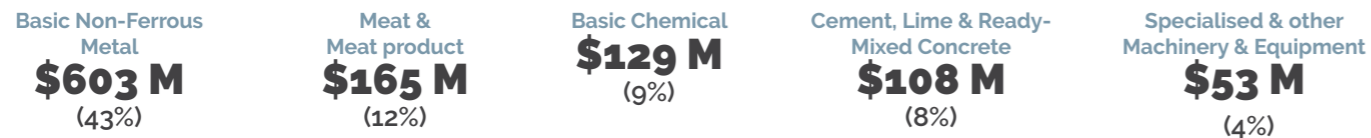

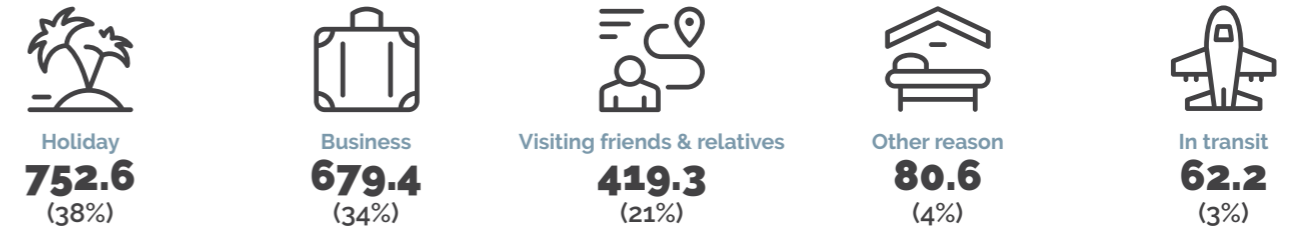

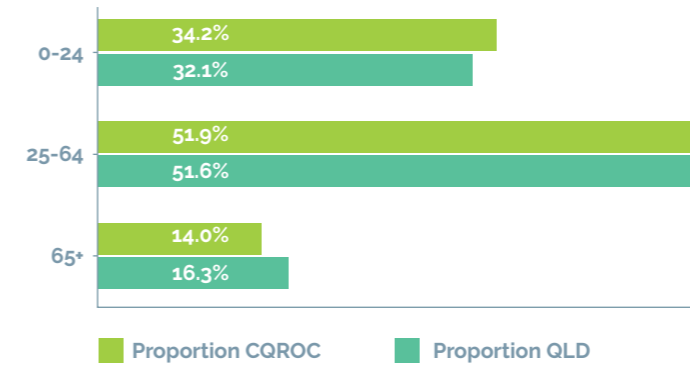
Top 5 industries by specialisation - (LQ):



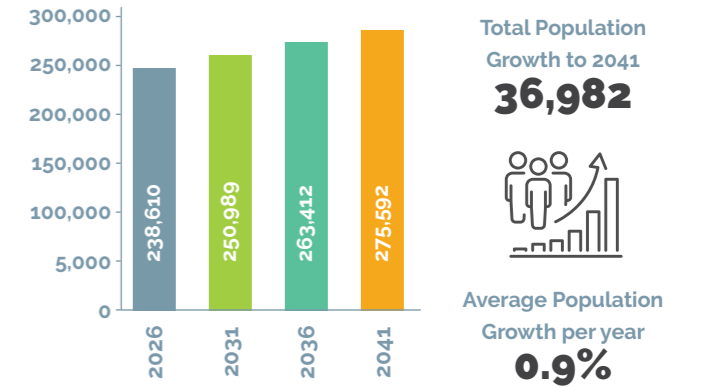

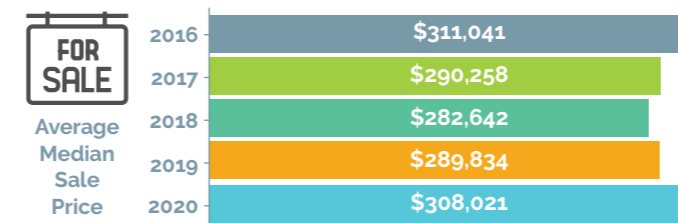
Total population & population by age:



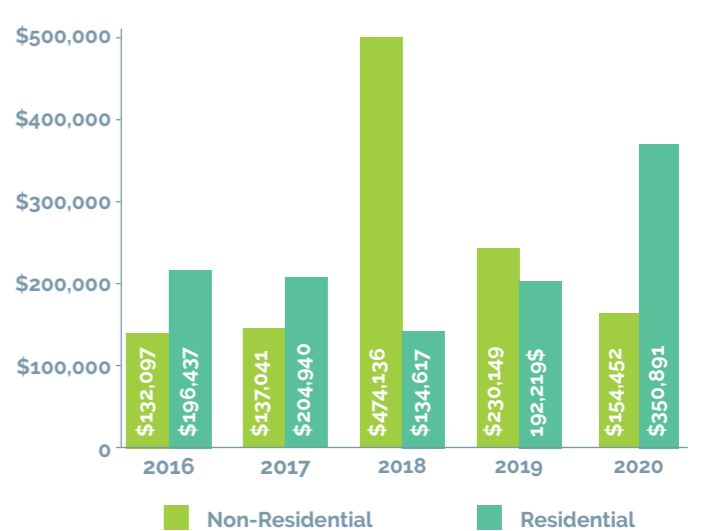

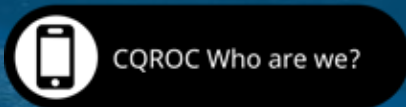
